

Leonard Malinoski Obituary

Bernardston, MA - Leonard Malinoski, 70, of 9 School Road, Bernardston, died on Saturday afternoon at the Baystate Medical Center in Springfield after a period of failing health.

He was born in Springfield on January 26, 1943, the son of Joseph and Dora (Frigon) Malinoski.

He was educated in Enfield, CT and Framingham schools and graduated from Framingham Union High School. In 1962 he joined the <u>U.S. Navy</u> and served during the Vietnam conflict. After his discharge, he later married Sandra Perchak in St. Stanislaus Church on February 7, 1970 officiated by Rev. Casimir Switalski. He was employed as a Tool & Die Maker working for Millers Falls Tool Co, Strathmore Paper and retired from Yankee Hill Machine in Florence, MA.
